### **Monday, October 5, 2026**

Location: Verkehrshaus Lucerne

We'll spend an exciting day at the Swiss Museum of Transport in Lucerne, where we'll explore the many exhibits on ships, trains, and airplanes in small groups. With various simulators, themed displays, and original artifacts, we'll immerse ourselves in the fascinating history of transportation by water, land, air, and space. In the afternoon, we can look forward to a journey to the stars at the planetarium. Of course, there will be plenty of time to play in the large playground arena, which features a traffic garden and a bike course.

### **Tuesday, October 6, 2026**

Location: Aeschbach Chocolagier & Zug Castle

Today we get to dive into the fascinating world of chocolate. At Aeschbach Chocolatier, we'll learn all about the history of chocolate and the routes cocoa takes to reach us through an interactive tour and a virtual boat ride. Afterward, we can create our own chocolate masterpiece with nuts, fruits, salty or spicy flavors...mmhh! After lunch, we'll head to Zug, where we'll explore Zug Castle on our own with the comic book character Lili.

### **Wednesday, October 7, 2026**

Location: Art house "Kunsthhaus Zurich" & Bowling

A creative morning awaits us at the Kunsthhaus Zürich, where we'll use a children's audio guide to dive into the world of artists. Each artwork marked with a penguin symbol tells its own story, and we'll have the chance to draw and create our own pictures. There's plenty to discover, and a few puzzles waiting to be solved. In the afternoon, we'll head to the kids' lanes for a game of bowling with lots of colorful balls!

### **Thursday, October 8, 2026**

Location: Milandia Padel & Mini-Golf

Let's play padel today! We'll give this new sport a try—it's a mix of tennis and squash. We'll play in teams of four on a court with glass walls, hitting the padel ball over the net to the other side with a padel racket...it's that simple! No prior experience is needed, and it's a lot of fun. In the afternoon, if the weather is nice, we'll go mini-golfing at Milandia, or if it's rainy, we'll head to an indoor mini-golf course.

### **Friday, October 9, 2026**

Location: Zurich Zoo

There's always something new to discover at the Zurich Zoo! We'll visit the Masoala Rainforest, the Elephant Park, and the giraffes and rhinos in the Lewa Savanna, and we'll get to marvel at the striking baobab trees. You'll also love the magnificent underwater worlds in the aquarium and the up-close animal encounters during giraffe feeding time.
