Monday, October 12, 2026

Location: Goldau Wildlife Park

At Goldau Wildlife Park, we take plenty of time to observe the more than 100 species of wild animals, such as wolves and bears. In the open-range area, we can treat the sika deer and mouflons to feed cubes and some petting, and we marvel at the climbing skills of the ibex. A delicious lunch awaits us at the cozy Restaurant Gans, so we'll have plenty of energy left to let off steam on the playgrounds afterward.

Tuesday, October 13, 2026

Location: Zurich Observatory

At the Urania Observatory, we can look forward to discovering the mysteries of the sky and the world of the stars. During a guided tour, the heart of the observatory—a giant telescope—will be explained to us in the dome room of the tower. If the weather is good, we can use it to see the moon, the planets, fixed stars, and even distant galaxies. After exploring the universe, we'll head back down to Earth to a unique adventure playground.

Wednesday, October 14, 2026

Location: Flying at Windwerk & Nature Museum

At Windwerk, we can experience the indescribable feeling of flying! Dressed in superhero suits, we'll learn to fly in a fun and playful way under expert guidance, so we can soar through the skies on two thrilling flights. Helmets, goggles, ear protection, and instructors ensure that we land safely and that this dream of flying will definitely remain unforgettable! After this experience, we'll head to the Winterthur Natural History Museum in the afternoon.

Thursday, October 15, 2026

Location: Technorama Winterthur

With its numerous exhibitions, demonstrations, and 500 hands-on stations, the Technorama interactive science center offers a playful introduction to science and technology. Through observation, levers, and cranks, we can learn fascinating facts about science and watch a presentation that explains the natural phenomenon of lightning. With Professor Bumbastic, we can look forward to plenty of magic as lasers dance, clouds appear out of nowhere, and the robot NAO speaks to us.

Friday, October 16, 2025

Location: BounceLab & Farm Bächlihof

There's always something going on at the BounceLab in Rüti! Lots of different trampolines invite you to jump, fly, and be amazed! Want to try a new jump? The trampoline instructors will be happy to show you the tricks for some cool jumps. There's also spinning soccer, table tennis, and a giant swinging cloth.
